- NEW ORGANIZATIONS MUST** submit proof of Federal 501(c)(3) status. If the organization does not have a federal non-profit status, please include a letter from the president or director on official letterhead outlining the organization's mission.
- Complete the 2012 Ticket Request Form.

2012 Kicks for Kids Guidelines

Kicks for Kids' organizations must abide by the guidelines listed below. **Failure to comply with the guidelines will result in removal from the program or loss of eligibility for future ticket distributions.**

1. Donated tickets must be used for youth with a ***limited*** number of tickets utilized for adults providing supervision and transportation.
2. Organizations must pick up tickets as a group at the Kicks for Kids tent on game days. A waiver must be submitted for **EACH** person utilizing a Kicks for Kids ticket. **No Exceptions.**
3. **Re-selling or misuse of donated tickets will result in automatic and permanent removal from the program.** Tickets must be used for the purpose outlined in the organization's letter.
4. Groups will be monitored on game days, if any behavior is found to be unacceptable in any way, the group will be removed from the program. Chaperones are responsible for supervising children at all times.
5. Organizations unable to utilize all donated tickets must give the Los Angeles Galaxy Foundation **one week's** notice in order to re-allocate the tickets.
6. Organizations must submit personalized thank you cards, pictures, or letters from the children no later than **one week** after attending a game. Correspondence must be addressed to "***Kicks for Kids Community Partners***" and mailed to: Los Angeles Galaxy Foundation, 18400 Avalon Boulevard, Suite 200, Carson, CA 90746.

ORGANIZATION VOLUNTARY WAIVER AND RELEASE AGREEMENT

This Voluntary Waiver and Release Agreement ("Agreement") is hereby executed by the undersigned [together with any successor, representative or assign, collectively as "Participant") in favor and for the sole and exclusive benefit of the Organizers (as defined herein). In connection with Participant's involvement in a program, contest, promotional activity or in any other event which may relate to a Los Angeles Galaxy Major League Soccer game or which may take place in connection with the Los Angeles Galaxy or the Kicks for Kids Program by Participant (the "Event"), Participant hereby certifies, warrants, represents, agrees and covenants to Anschutz L.A. Soccer, Inc., Los Angeles Galaxy Foundation, Anschutz Southern California Sports Complex, LLC, Anschutz Entertainment Group, Inc., Major League Soccer, L.L.C. and any of the respective Event sponsors or promoters (individually and collectively, together with their respective affiliates, officers, employees, partners, shareholders, members, sponsors, contractors, agents, successors and assigns, the "Organizers") that Participant is:

- (1) ENTERING INTO THIS WAIVER AND RELEASE AGREEMENT VOLUNTARILY AND WITHOUT ANY UNDUE INFLUENCE FROM ORGANIZERS OR ANY OTHER THIRD PARTY;
- (2) DERIVES A MATERIAL BENEFIT FROM THE EVENT AND/OR PARTICIPANT'S INVOLVEMENT THEREIN; AND
- (3) HEREBY RELEASES, FOREVER DISCHARGES, INDEMNIFIES AND HOLDS HARMLESS ORGANIZERS FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THE EVENT AND ANY ACTIVITY ASSOCIATED THEREWITH. "CLAIMS" SHALL BE DEFINED AS ALL MANNER OF ACTION OR ACTIONS, CAUSE OR CAUSES OF ACTION, IN LAW OR IN EQUITY, SUITS, DEBTS, LIENS, CONTRACTS, PROMISES, COMPENSATION, LIABILITIES, INJURY TO PERSON OR PROPERTY, CLAIMS, PREDICATE ACTS, DEMANDS, DAMAGES, LOSSES, COSTS OR EXPENSES, OF ANY NATURE WHATSOEVER, KNOWN OR UNKNOWN, FIXED OR CONTINGENT, DIRECT OR INDIRECT THAT PARTICIPANT MAY HAVE AGAINST ORGANIZERS. PARTICIPANT AGREES TO DEFEND AND HOLD THE ORGANIZERS HARMLESS FROM ANY LOSS OR DAMAGES, INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES AND COSTS, SUSTAINED BY ORGANIZERS, OR ANY ONE OR MORE OF THEM, AS A RESULT OF PARTICIPANT'S RECISSION OF THIS AGREEMENT OR BREACH OF ITS COVENANTS OR AGREEMENTS CONTAINED IN THIS PARAGRAPH

Participant further agrees that the Organizers shall have the right to record, broadcast and otherwise exploit in any and all media throughout the world Participant's activity/performance in the Event and to use Participant's name and likeness in connection therewith.

If any provision of this Agreement shall for any reason be held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision hereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid or unenforceable provision were omitted.

The validity, interpretation, construction and enforcement of this Agreement shall be governed and controlled by the laws of the State of California, without regard to that State's rules with respect to choice of law.

THE WAIVER AND RELEASE GRANTED BY PARTICIPANT HEREUNDER IS LEGALLY BINDING AND SHALL BE CONSIDERED IRREVOCABLE. PARTICIPANT AGREES THAT THE ORGANIZERS MAY RELY UPON THIS AGREEMENT TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMISSIBLE AT LAW OR IN EQUITY.
